
## His Divine Grace


AC Bhaktivedanta Swami Shrila Prabhupada was a simple monk living on madhukari (taking alms) in

Vrindavan. Due to strong impulses coming from his spiritual master, Shrila Bhaktisidhanta Saraswati Maharaj, at the age of 70, he went to New York, USA, to spread love of God, Krishna, to the western world. Here he amassed a large following, which turned into the International Society for Krishna Consciousness. His last message before he took samadhi was:


"Don't waste time on bodily comforts. You have to eat something. You have to cover yourself. So produce your own food and cloth. Don't be allured by the machine civilization. Don't waste time on luxury, and chant Hare Krishna. About money, spend for Krishna, for Krishna's palace, for Krishna's temple, for Krishna's worship. I wanted to introduce this. Now I have given you ideas. You can do it. You are all intelligent.

For Chaitanya Mahaprabhu's para-upkar... so you do good to others. Not exploit others. Any human being who has been bestowed by this body has the capacity to chant Hare Krishna. Give them a chance and make the situation favourable. Is that clear?"

According to the Vedic system, a cow is considered a mother of mankind. Our biological mothers give us milk for a year or two. Thereafter for all our life, cows give us milk. Moreover a cow's dung and urine are invaluable to make compost for growing our food. Most of all, the cow emanates peace and love. Being very dear to Lord Krishna, she is our object of worship and service.

At Karuna, presently we have a cob-shed to accommodate three cows. We aim to build a larger shed and expand the grazing space to be a comfortable home to 7 cows, 7 calves, and a bull.

It is scientifically proven that the Indian breeds provide the healthiest milk, with almost no cases of lactose intolerance. We intend to establish the "Gir" breed and spread awareness and propagate its importance in nearby villages.

Organic Farming


We are humbled by Nature's greatness and want to live in harmony within our ecosystem. Our goal is to grow 75% of the food we consume. Presently we grow 20 varieties of fruits and have a solar-fenced area for growing vegetables. We research and practice various methods of farming, like organic manure, earthworms, companion planting, bio-dynamic practices. We also hold regular workshops and training programs to spread the knowledge that we have accumulated in our years off-the-grid.







The initiator of this devotional endeavour is Mahamsa Swami (Nevil Moncher). While in Toronto, Canada, at the age of 19, he became the first Indian disciple of His Divine Grace AC Bhaktivedanta Swami Prabhupada. In 1983 he came to Kodaikanal to continue his sadhana in solitude. Here he regenerated the forest, fought many organisations to preserve nature and developed Karuna to what it is today.

### Krishna and the Fruit Vendor

Once, when Lord Krishna was engaged in His childhood pastimes in Vrndavan, a fruit vendor came selling fruits from house-to-house. In those days there was no currency and the barter system of exchanging commodities was the practice. Lord Krishna had seen His father and other elders bartering butter, curds and grains for other essential commodities.

Imitating such activities of the elders, Lord Krishna brought a handful of rice grains and held it out to the fruit vendor. Baby Krishna could barely walk and his little lotus palms could hold only a few grains of rice. The fruit vendor, captivated by the beauty and innocent dealings of baby Krishna, took those few grains of rice and placed in His hand several fruit; even more than He could hold. When the fruit vendor turned around she found in her basket, rubies and diamonds in place of fruits.

So when we give something to Lord Krishna, we never lose. On the other hand, we gain a thousand more not only materially, but also spiritually.
